- 1- All persons in charge of stock shall be subject to the orders of the judges and officials of the Strathardle Highland Gathering.
- 2- The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entries or to cancel any entry made.
- 3- A responsible person appointed by the exhibitor, must be in attendance on stock entered, unless specific arrangements have been made with an official.
- 4- No protest will be considered unless lodged verbally with the judge at the time of judging and confirmed in writing with the Show Secretary within 3 clear days from the date of the Show. In case of dispute, the decision of the Committee shall be final.
- 5- The Committee its officers and Servants shall not be responsible for any accident, damage or loss however caused, that may occur to any exhibitor or his servant or spectator or stock or property brought into the grounds or while entering or leaving the said grounds.
- 6- Prizes will be paid in accordance with the scales published on the day of the Show except in cases of dispute when payment will be made at the discretion of the Committee.

- 7- Trophies will remain the property of the Committee and must be returned to the Show Secretary by the 1st July of the following year. The winner of a trophy shall be responsible for its safe custody and preservation during the aforesaid period.
- 8- Exhibitors to have farm holding number in Show area **OR** reside in show area **OR** be employed in Show area.
- 9 - Any sheep entered for the shepherds class may be entered in the open (shepherds class includes all hired employees).
- 10 - All stock entered must have been the **Bona Fide** property of the exhibitor for six months prior to the Show.
- 11- Pair of calves not be shown in any other Class but exhibitors can show one of the pair in their individual championship.
- 12 - All male calves to be castrated.
- 13 - Stockmen must leave judging ring if requested to do so by stewards in attendance.
- 14 - **ALL STOCK TO REMAIN ON FIELD UNTIL 3PM.**
